


MONDAY, MARCH 2: cont...

- Travel via cycle rickshaw (pedi-cab) through the narrow lanes of Chandni chowk, originally renowned for its tree lined canal flowing down its center. The rickshaw ride will end at the Red Fort for a visit from inside. The magical monument in red sandstone was built at the pinnacle of the Mogul empire.
- Enjoy lunch at your leisure. We will be happy to provide recommendations and reservations. (not included)
- After lunch, enjoy some time to explore a local market nearby, where you can look for jewelry, textiles, art and more.
 Alternatively, you may return directly to the hotel to rest and refresh. OR... Visit Gandhi Smriti, a museum dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi.
- Evening at your own leisure

TUESDAY, MARCH 3:

• This morning you will have a private road transfer to Agra - the city of Taj Mahal (approx. a 4 hour drive)





- Upon arrival in Agra, check into your room at The Oberoi Amarvilas
- In the afternoon visit Taj Mahal.
 - o Mughal emperor, Shahjahan built this architectural wonder to enshrine the mortal remains of his beloved Queen Mumtaz Mahal. Fashioned from white marble with semi-precious pietra dura stone inlay work.
- In the evening, dinner will be served at Esphahan- Live traditional music filters through a mosaic of candlelit tables where you can enjoy recipes passed down from the Mughal Emperors' kitchen.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4:

- 6am: Those who may wish to go back to the Taj Mahal for a dawn visit, will join Werner & Myra in the lobby.
- Return to the hotel for breakfast. Later drive to Bharatpur (approx. a 1hr drive) to connect to the afternoon train to Sawai Madhopur.
 - En route an early lunch will be arranged at a heritage hotel in Bharatpur.
- The train is expected to arrive at about 2:50pm. On arrival, you will be greeted and have a private road transfer to The Oberoi Vanyavilas.






- Ranthambore is considered by many to be one of India's most beautiful
 national parks because of the picturesque ruins that dot the wildlife park.
 Encircled by a series of high escarpments, the forests, lakes and dry scrub
 that make up the park are dotted with old forts and temples, creating a
 wonderful atmosphere for both bird and mammal viewing amongst a
 landscape oozing with ancient Rajput history and Rajasthani culture.
- Return to the hotel for a late breakfast. After breakfast enjoy some down town or enjoy facilities at the hotel
- Lunch will be served at the hotel. In the afternoon, take another round of Jeep safari with a naturalist exploring wildlife and biodiversity in the park.
- Enjoy dinner at the hotel

FRIDAY, MARCH 6:

• After breakfast, you will have a private road transfer to Jaipur- the colorful capital of Rajasthan known as the pink city.



SATURDAY, MARCH 7:

- Today you will embark on a tour of the city starting with the imposing 16th century Amber Fort. Set on a hilltop overlooking Maota Lake.
 - Enjoy a jeep ride ascending the fort with lovely views of the topography and monuments around along the way.
- On the way back from Amber Fort, you will stop by the Hawa Mahal, also known as the Palace of Winds. The honeycomb structure was built in the 18th century.
- This afternoon, visit the City Palace and the Jantar Mantar (observatory).
 - Continue your visit to the open air observatory Jantar Mantar built by Maharaja Jai Singh. It is the largest stone and marble crafted observatory in the world.
- For the more adventure-inclined participants, a tuk-tuk ride can be arranged around the local market area.



SATURDAY, MARCH 7:


- The rest of the afternoon is at leisure to explore the markets of Jaipur with transport and guide available, prior return to the hotel.
 - The city is famous for Gems and Jewelry and traditional hand block painted fabrics, antique textiles, carpets and handicrafts.
- This evening, come together for a farewell dinner at Raj Mahal.
 - serving unusual dishes drawn from the remote corners of India, sometimes deconstructed and reinvented by their chefs. This will be a Thali dinner (pre-plated dinner with a variety of Indian dishes).

SUNDAY, MARCH 8:

- Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel.
- Later the group will have a private road transfer to the airport for your flight back to Delhi
- After collecting your luggage in Delhi you will be greeted and transferred to the Andaz Delhi by Hyatt hotel
- Overnight at the Andaz (you could leave later tonight if you would like)

MONDAY, MARCH 9:

 Private road transfer back to the airport in time for your international flight home
