## **THURSDAY, MAY 28:**

- Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) in Nairobi, you will be met immediately off your flight by a representative for special assistance through immigration and your private road transfer to Hemingways Nairobi
- Rest of day at your own leisure

## **FRIDAY, MAY 29:**

- This morning you will have a private road transfer to Wilson Airport (WIL) for your light aircraft flight to Il Moran Camp in the northwestern corner of the legendary Maasai Mara National Reserve.
  - *\*Luggage is limited to 15kg per person in soft-sided bags.*
  - *\*This flight is currently scheduled to depart Wilson at 10:00am and arrive Musiara at 11:00am. There may be stops en route.*







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# MASAI MARA NATIONAL PARK

One of Kenya's undisputed natural highlights is the Masai Mara National Reserve, which sprawls across more than 1500 square kilometres of the country's southwest. The park protects a phenomenal array of game, including elephant, lion, leopard and buffalo, as well as crocodile and hippopotamus in the Mara River. The birdlife is no less impressive, with over 450 resident bird species. However, the true highlight here is the Great Migration, recognised as one of the Seven New Wonders of the World. To survive the dry months of July to September, some 1.7 million wildebeest, migrate from the parched plains of the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania. Along with much smaller numbers of antelope, buffalo and zebra, they move to the more forgiving grasslands of the Masai Mara.

In their wake come predators such as lion, hyena and cheetah, for whom these giant herds are an easy source of prey.







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# IL MORAN CAMP

*Masai Mara National Park*

Il Moran Camp is an intimate and peaceful camp. The camp, nestled under the canopy of riverine forest, consists of just 10 luxurious tents situated along the winding banks of the Mara River. Meals are served on the raised wooden decking of the main mess and dining tent, providing a bird's-eye view of the Mara River and its resident hippos. A central sunken fire pit is lit in the evenings, offering the perfect place to relax with a cocktail

## **SUNDAY, MAY 31:**

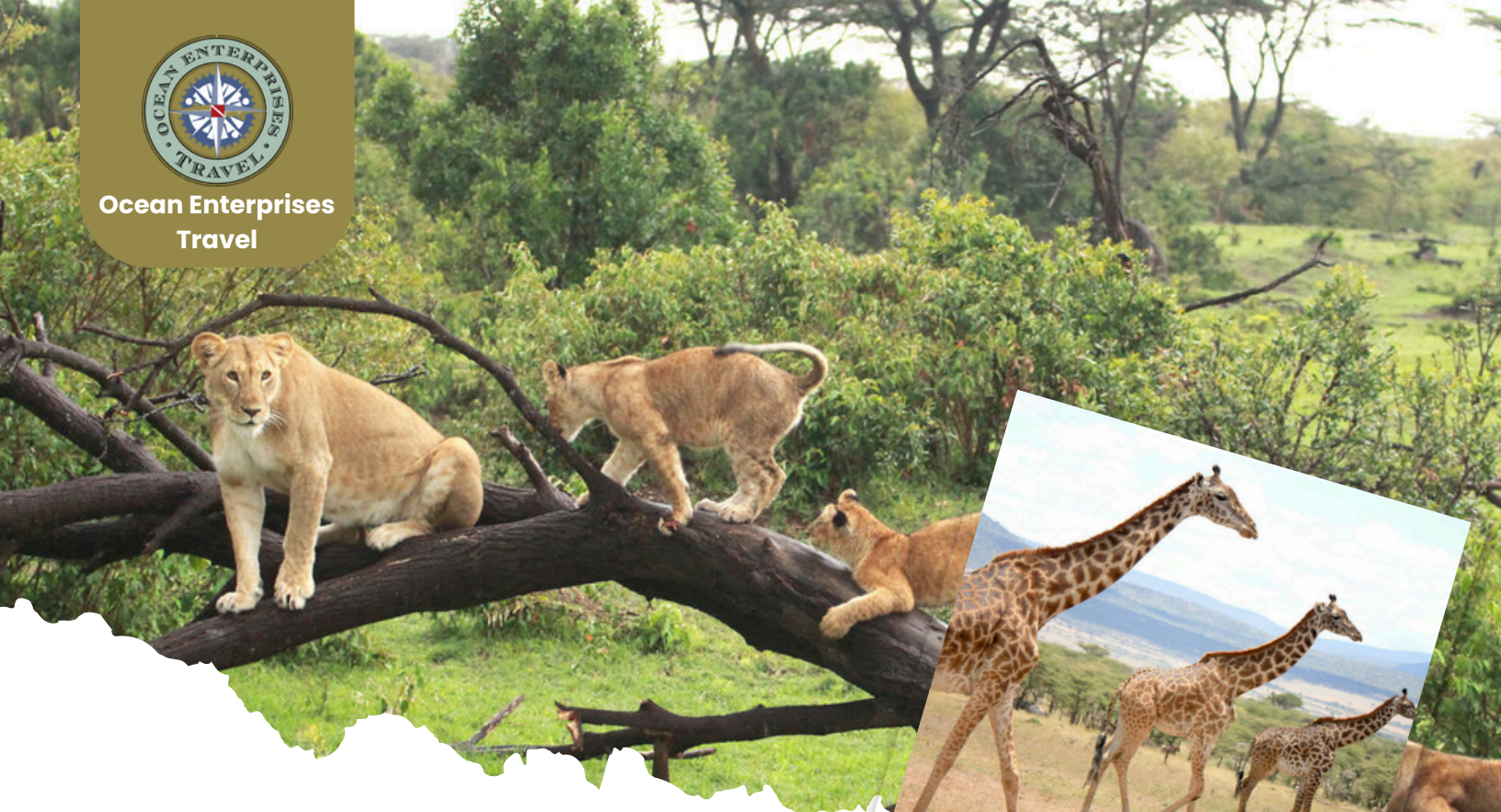
- Today you will transfer to Naboisho Camp, situated in the private Naboisho Conservancy on the northern border of the national reserve.







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# MARA NABOISHO CONSERVANCY

Bordering the Masai Mara National Reserve to the southwest, the Olare Orok Conservancy to the west and the Ol Kinyei Conservancy to the east, the Mara Naboisho Conservancy is comprised of over 50 000 hectares of unspoilt wilderness in Kenya's Greater Mara Region. The area is renowned for its bountiful biodiversity and breathtaking natural beauty with a wide range of wildlife on offer including lion, cheetah, elephant, giraffe, wild dog, and a host of plains game. Visitors can look forward to guided walking safaris, spending the night in a transient fly camp, heading out on a night game drive in search of elusive nocturnal creatures, joining the Mara Naboisho Lion Project as they track lions across the conservancy, or visiting Maasai villages to learn about the fascinating indigenous culture.







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# NABOISHO CAMP

*Naboisho Conservancy*

Set in the 210km<sup>2</sup> private Mara Naboisho Conservancy, Naboisho offers spectacular game viewing, from the herds of antelope that dot the plains of this wilderness corridor throughout the year to the high concentrations of predators, including lion and cheetah. But the real magic of Naboisho is its sheer exclusivity – you'll experience a level of safari solitude and serenity simply unheard of in the busy Serengeti and Masai Mara.

## **SUNDAY, MAY 31–TUESDAY, JUNE 2:**

- Enjoy this private conservancy!
  - *Game drives, night drives, walking safaris, fly camping, cultural & community visits, and hot air ballooning, (some of the activities are at an extra charge)*

## **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3:**

- This morning you will transfer to the airstrip for your private light aircraft flight to Lewa Wilderness on a private conservancy on Kenya's famous Laikipia plateau.
  - *\*Luggage is limited to 15kg per person in soft-sided bags.*
  - *\*This private flight will likely be in two Cessna C208 Caravans and has an estimated duration of 1 hour 15 minutes.*







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# LEWA CONSERVANCY

Spanning over thousands of hectares of vast open savannah grasslands in northern Kenya, Lewa Wildlife Conservancy is home to the world's largest population of Grevy's zebra. Renowned as a pioneer and leader in responsible tourism, Lewa Wildlife Conservancy actively advances and develops community engagement and wildlife conservation. It has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site and serves as an important sanctuary for a large selection of wildlife including the endangered black rhino as well as the white rhino. Lewa offers visitors the opportunity to have close encounters with these prehistoric creatures against an unspoilt backdrop, making it one of Kenya's top game-viewing destinations. Boasting one of the highest wildlife densities in Kenya, the park is also inhabited by elephants, lions, buffalo, wild dogs, giraffes, cheetahs, and over 400 bird species.







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# LEWA WILDERNESS LODGE

*Laikipia Plateau*

Lewa Wilderness is one of Kenya's oldest private safari experiences. Guests can relax by the fire in the cozy sitting room and share meals around a long banquet table in the open-air dining room. Natural springs, home-raised livestock, and a 5-acre organic garden are transformed by skilled chefs into incredible, healthy and delicious food. There is a very good chance of seeing all of the "Big Five" and Lewa is one of the only game parks where visitors are almost guaranteed to see the endangered black & white rhinos.

## **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3-FRIDAY, JUNE 5:**

- Explore this incredible property and all it has to offer!
  - *Game drives, night drives, walking with Masai, horse riding, camel riding, farm visits, fly camping, Lewa crafts, Ngare Ndare Forest, cultural visits, flying the wilds.*

## **SATURDAY, JUNE 6:**

- Early this morning you will transfer to the airstrip for your private light aircraft flight back to Nairobi (WIL).
  - *\*Luggage is limited to 15kg per person in soft-sided bags.*
  - *\*This private flight will likely be in two Cessna C208 Caravans and has an estimated duration of 45 minutes.*
- Upon arrival at Wilson Airport (WIL) in Nairobi, you will be met by private guides/vehicles who will be at your disposal for the day.
- You will ultimately be transferred back to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) where you will have special assistance with connecting to your departing commercial flights.
