

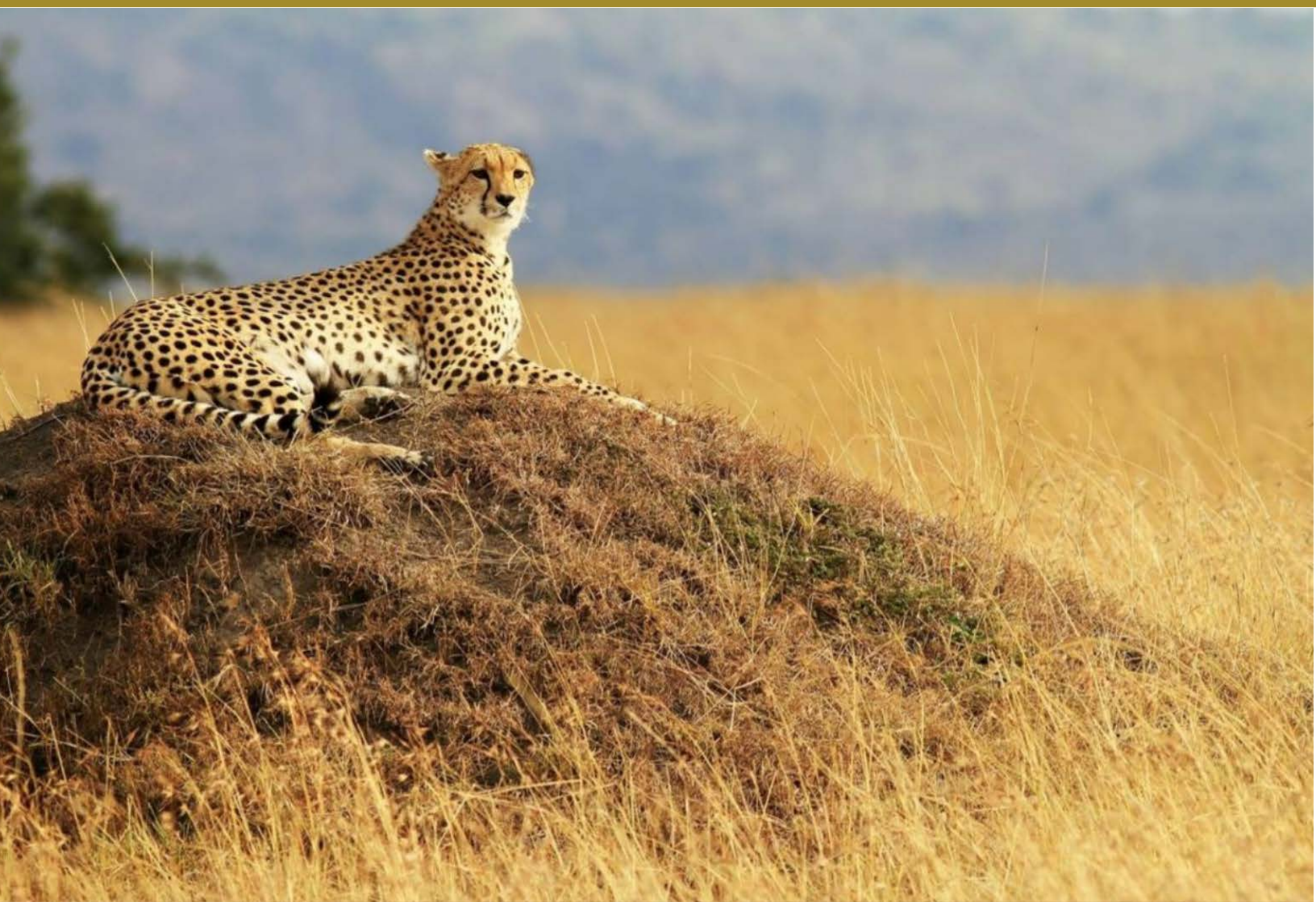

FRIDAY, MAY 26

Arrival into Nairobi

Hemingways Nairobi (1 night, May 26-27)

A member of the Small Luxury Hotels of the World, it is considered the best boutique hotel in Nairobi.

SATURDAY, MAY 27

Light aircraft flight to Il Moran Camp

Il Moran Camp (2 nights, May 27-29)

Part of the Governor's Camp collection, Il Moran is regarded as a premiere camp in the Maasai Mara.

MONDAY, MAY 29

Game Drive to Naboisho Camp

Naboisho Camp (3 nights, May 29-June 1)

Set in a private reserve, this luxury Asilia camp offers spectacular game viewing.

THURSDAY, JUNE 1

Light aircraft flight to Lewa Wilderness Lodge (3 nights, June 1-4)

Lewa sits at the base of Mount Kenya in the wild-life rich Lewa Conservancy.

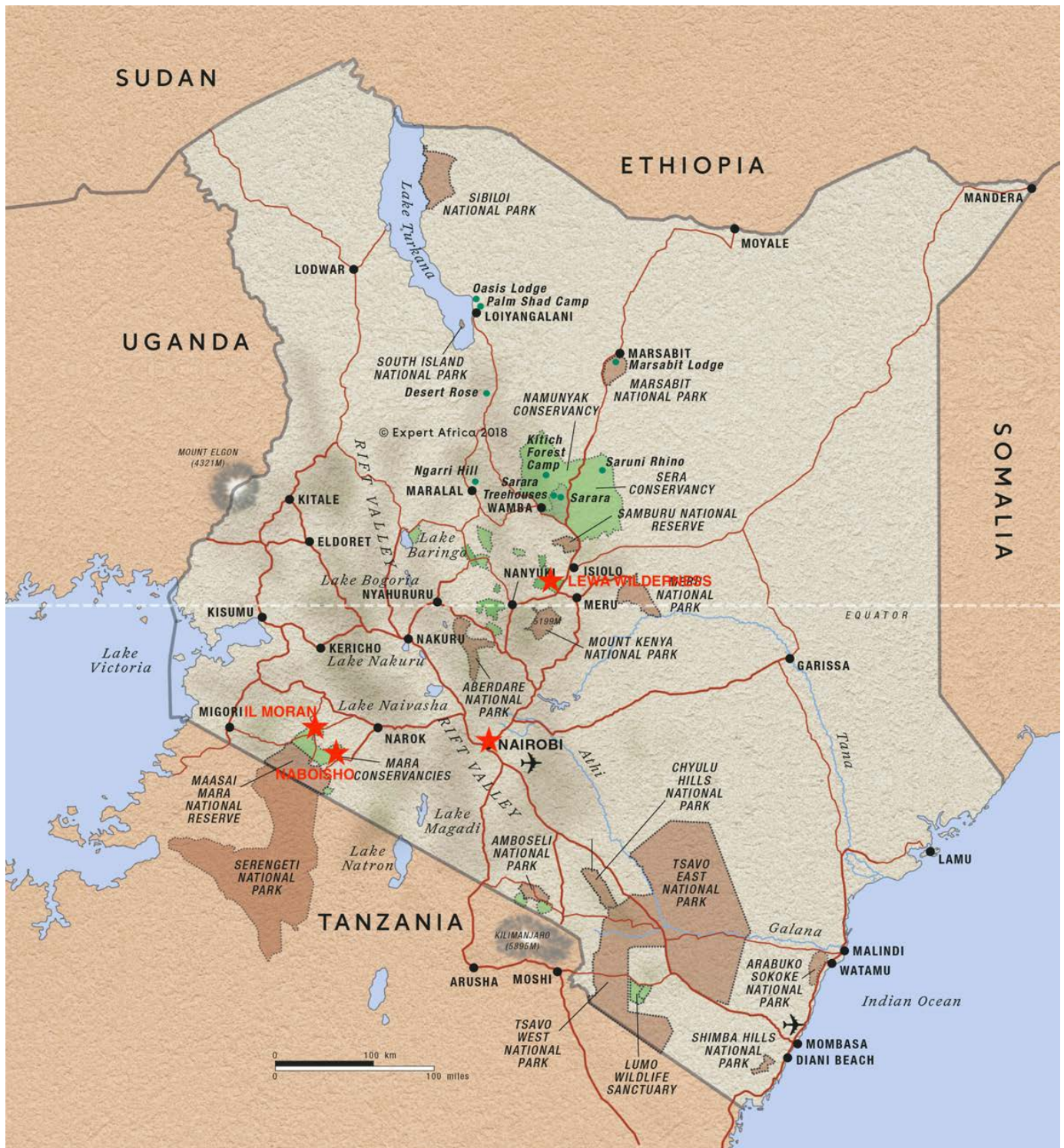
SUNDAY, JUNE 4

Light aircraft flight back to Wilson Airport.

Transfer to Nairobi international Airport for your departure flights.

FRIDAY, MAY 26

Upon your arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) in Nairobi, you will be met immediately off your flight for special assistance through immigration and for your private road transfer to Hemingway's Nairobi.

HEMINGWAYS NAIROBI

May 26 - 27

*1 Night Stay in a Deluxe Suite

SATURDAY, MAY 27

This morning you will have a private road transfer to Wilson Airport for your light aircraft flight to Il Moran Camp in the heart of the legendary Maasai Mara National Reserve.

Luggage is limited to 33 lb in soft-sided bags.

IL MORAN CAMP

May 27 - 29

*Two Night Stay in a Tented Room

*All Meals, Private Daily Activities, Park Fees, House Drinks (excluding some premium drinks), and Laundry included

Part of the Governor's Camp Collection, Il Moran consists of just 10 luxurious tents situated along the winding banks of the Mara River. Meals are served on the raised wooden decking of the main tent, providing a bird's-eye view of the Mara River and its resident hippos. A central sunken fire pit is lit in the evenings, offering the perfect place to relax with a cocktail.

Each of the spacious tents have a private verandah and en-suite bathroom with bathtub and large shower.



SUNDAY, MAY 28

Highly trained and experienced guides head up daily game drives in custom-made vehicles to some of the best viewing areas in the Reserve.

Walking safaris take place in a private concession area adjacent to the Masai Mara Game Reserve giving a different view and experience than found on game drives.

Maasai cultural visits to Mara Rianda, a traditional community, show a way of life almost virtually unchanged for centuries.

Hot air balloon rides can be scheduled in advance for an additional cost.

MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

As southern Kenya's premiere wildlife sanctuary, the Mara merges with Tanzania's Serengeti National Park to form an exceptional 6,000 square mile conservation area that is home to an incredible diversity of wildlife.

All of Africa's "big five" call the Maasai Mara home: lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, and rhino. In addition, many antelope species flourish including Grant's gazelles, impalas, duikers, Coke's hartebeests, and roan antelopes. Hippopotamus and Nile crocodile inhabit the Mara and Talek rivers, which are the major suppliers of fresh water to the reserve.



MONDAY, MAY 29

This morning you will game drive to Naboisho Camp in the private Naboisho Conservancy on the northern border of the Masai Mara National Reserve.

NABOISHO CAMP

May 29 - June 1

*Three Night Stay in a Tented Room

*All Meals, Private Daily Activities, Park Fees, House Drinks (excluding some premium drinks), and Laundry included

Set on a private conservancy, Naboisho Camp offers spectacular game viewing in a setting of sheer exclusivity. Expert guides lead guests on bush walks, night drives and wilderness excursions, offering exclusive and unparalleled access to one of the most remarkable natural areas on the planet. Each of the eight luxurious tented suites at Naboisho Camp offer private facilities and king-size beds, with large screen windows to let the sights and sounds of the Kenyan wilderness astound you at every turn.





May 30 & 31

Enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives, picnics and sundowners.
When back at the camp, enjoy a cup of tea or a cocktail and watch the wildlife from the outdoor viewing deck.



MARA NABOISHO CONSERVANCY

This private conservancy borders the Masai Mara National Reserve. It has a dense wildlife population, including a particular high number of lions. Expect to see giraffe, elephant, zebras, big cats and lots more!



THURSDAY, JUNE 1

This morning you will transfer to the airstrip for your light aircraft flight to Lewa Wilderness Lodge on a private conservancy on Kenya's famous Laikipia plateau.

Luggage is limited to 33 lb in soft-sided bags.

LEWA WILDERNESS LODGE

June 1 - 4

**Three Night Stay in a Cottage*

**All Meals, Private Daily Activities, Park Fees, House Drinks and Laundry included*

Upon arrival, guests will feel the peace and tranquility of the grounds. Each of the hillside cottages were built to capture the stunning views over the valley and have en-suite facilities, a cozy sitting area and fireplace, and a private outdoor verandah.

The main lodge has an inviting sitting area with an extensive library of books and is also where afternoon tea and coffee is served.

Cool off in the saltwater infinity pool, or visit the yoga deck, gym or the tennis court.





JUNE 2 & 3

Choose from day and night game drives, picnics and sundowners.

Go on a horseback or a camel safari.

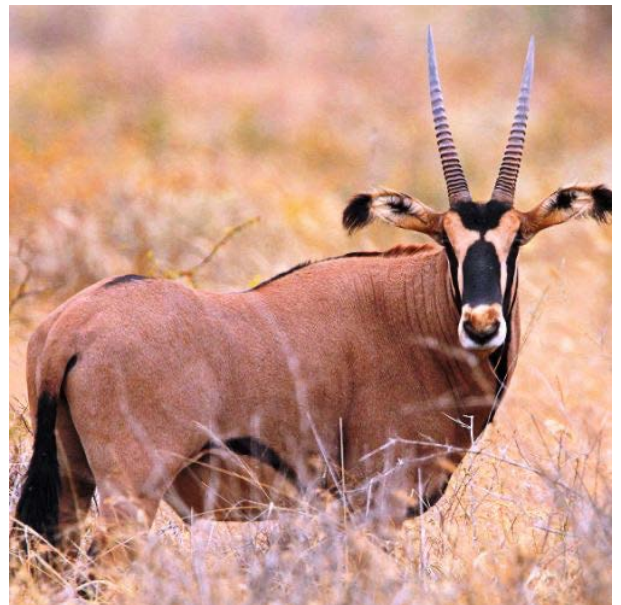
Take a guided walk or relax by the infinity pool.

THE LEWA EXPERIENCE

The Lewa Wildlife Conservancy is a wildlife sanctuary located in northern Kenya and covers over 62,000 acres. It is home to some of the most endangered species in Africa, including the Black Rhino, White Rhino, Grevy's Zebra, Reticulated Giraffe, and the Fringe Eared Oryx.

Here you can also have an opportunity meet the rangers and have a glimpse of the fight that goes on behind the scenes to keep the wildlife safe.

In addition to safari game drives, guests can also choose to see the conservancy on horseback or by camel.



SUNDAY, JUNE 4

This morning you will transfer to the airstrip for your light aircraft flight back to Wilson Airport Nairobi.

Upon your arrival at Wilson Airport, you will be met by your private guides who will drive you to the Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage where a private visit has been arranged for you.



After the visit, there is free time for shopping or further exploration in Nairobi with the guides/vehicles until it is time to return to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) where you will have special assistance with connecting to your departing commercial flights.
